The Best New Paris Hotels in Fall 2019

A new wave of hotel openings means travelers are (even more) spoilt for choice when booking their next trip to Paris. Here are six of our favorite most fashionable new addresses to check into this fall.

Ballu

Already a favorite hangout with the locals of Paris' 8th and 17th neighborhoods, the Ballu comes with an attractive leafy courtyard spot that's perfect for al fresco dining.

Steps away from bustling Place the Clichy and the cocktail bars of Pigalle, the hotel has its own underlit bar that adjoins the Art Deco style restaurant where the chef rustles up hearty dishes of baked leek and roast chicken with crunchy vegetables.



Upstairs, the rooms come in block colors like midnight blue and mustard yellow, and many have their own balcony or terrace looking across at the honey-colored stone buildings on the street (go for room 51 for the prettiest outdoor space). And to unwind fully, there is a gem of a spa tiled in Art Nouveau mint green and cream hues that has a pool and sauna that hotel guests must book by the hour (complimentary).
